Household Hazardous Waste Department Remote Collection Program

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) - The Sedgwick County Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Facility have planned five Household Hazardous Materials Remote Collection Events throughout Sedgwick County. Residents are encouraged to participate on the weekend set aside for your area. Sedgwick County HHW will accept the same materials that are accepted at the main HHW facility (see attached fact sheet for more information on what materials are accepted).

The items that are **NOT ACCEPTED** at the Remote Collection Sites or the main HHW Facility are:

- Asbestos
- Tires
- Appliances
- Recyclables (Glass, Plastic, Paper, etc.)
- Explosives
- Radioactive materials
- Biological Waste (Sharps)

“The HHW Facility is a great service that is provided to our residents free of charge,” said Sedgwick County Commission Chairman Dave Unruh. “The Remote Collection Events are one more way we are bringing our services to our residents.”
