### **Sedgwick County Appraiser Mailed Personal Property Value Notices**

(Sedgwick County, Kansas) – The Sedgwick County Appraiser's Office will mail approximately 51,000 personal property renditions beginning December 29, 2006 for the year 2007. Renditions can be expected in mailboxes beginning December 30, 2006.

By state statute, anyone who owns taxable personal property in Sedgwick County as of January 1<sup>st</sup> should file a rendition with the Appraiser's Office. Those affected include business owners or individuals owning personal items such as aircraft, boats, trailers, non-highway vehicles, or manufactured homes. Those individuals who have opened a new business on or before June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2006 or those individuals who purchased new personal property before January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 also need to file a rendition with the Appraiser's Office.

Renditions are being mailed to those whose property is currently listed on the tax roll. If a rendition does not arrive in the mail, one can be requested by calling the Sedgwick County Call Center at (316) 660-9110 or by e-mail on the Appraiser's web page, [www.sedgwickcounty.org](http://www.sedgwickcounty.org).

The deadline for filing personal property renditions is March 15, 2007; the deadline for filing Oil and Gas renditions is April 1, 2007. Taxpayers need to verify information for accuracy, check the appropriate certification box, sign and submit their filing to the Appraiser's Office. Unsigned renditions cannot be accepted and will be returned to taxpayers for signature. Filing the rendition on or before the appropriate deadline will prevent late filing penalties of up to 50%.
