

Aaron Breitenbach is the Chief Attorney for the District Attorney's Traffic Division and oversees the attorneys who work in the division with the goal of making sure you and other residents are in compliance with the traffic laws in Sedgwick County. The Traffic Division handles more than 25,000 traffic cases filed by the Office of the District Attorney each year.
