On the recommendation of Jerry Phipps, on behalf of the Sheriff’s Office, Don Brace moved to **accept the low bid meeting specifications from Applied Concepts for \$14,988.00**. Ron Holt seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Note: The units in the low bid from MPH were tested and it was found that there were problems with a failure to operate after installation of unit and after factory re-work the units produced inaccurate readings. The units bid by Decatur Electronics produced faulty readings (called ghosting) and had problems with the remote control units.
