The following are questions related to Request for Proposal 09-0022. Questions are in **bold** and answers are in *italics*.

- 1. What are the current rates for collect calls made from the jail?**

- 2. What is the commission the current provider is paying to Sedgwick County?**

- 3. Should vendors return the entire document, including the original RFP to the County?**
Vendors may choose to only submit a response, as long as the format is the same as the original document, using the same section and item numbers in your response would help with this. The proposal response form MUST be included, along with any other requested information.
- 4. Page 3, Item 6, Will the County clarify that the \$100,000.00 prepaid commission is for the first year only? Also, is the \$25,000.00 fee for subsequent years to be considered a prepaid fee or a technology fee?**
The \$100,000.00 is a prepaid fee for year one only. The \$25,000.00 fee for subsequent years is considered a prepaid fee.
- 5. Who is the current provider of Inmate Phone Service?**
GTL
- 6. Please clarify how many computer workstations/personnel will need to access the system.**
The County has a need for four (4) workstations that will allow access to the system. These systems are to be designated by County staff.

7. **Does staff needing access to the system have computers, and if so, they have internet access with a fixed IP address?**

County is unable to answer this question fully at this time.

8. **What category of cable is currently going into the phones?**

Category 5

9. **What type of internet service does the County have?**

Redundant connections, managed fiber (TLS) and T1.

10. **Who provides internet service to Sedgwick County?**

Cox Business and Sprint

11. **Number and type of roll around phones existing and/or to be installed?**

One (1) in the clinic.

12. **Number and type of TDD phones existing and/or to be installed?**

There are a total of three (3) and they are Ultratec phones for the deaf.

13. **The RFP states cord length is to be 15 inches, standard lengths are 12 inches and 18 inches, anything under 18 inches has a tendency to hold the handset up off the hook switch and keep the phone off hook, will the County consider using the industry standard 18 inch cord?**

On phones with cords mounted on the top portion of the phone, cords will be 18 inches, phones with bottom mounted cords, will be 24 inches.

14. **On handicap phones (ADA), a longer cord is often used (usually 24 inches) to allow for easier use. Will the County consider this option?**

According to ADA standards, cord lengths must be at least 29", County will abide by this standard.

15. **Questions continue to be asked about prepay cards and debit cards as a solution for the inmate phone system.**

The Detention facility does not have the means or man power to manage a card system. If vendors have a solution whereby they want to offer a system with the ability to manage and maintain their system with no help from detention facility resources, such a system may be proposed as an option and must include detail of the entire system, including but not limited to, how the system functions, processes to manage the system, vendor resources to manage the system, any equipment provided to manage and maintain the system, etc. The proposed option must also meet all other requirements, terms and conditions outlined in the RFP.

The County reserves the right to solely determine the best proposal for award that fits the needs of the detention facility. It should also be noted that should the County choose a card system option, the County also reserves the right to determine the success of such a program and if it deems to be in its best interest, discontinue the card system with 30 days written notice to the vendor.


