(Sedgwick County, Kan.) – In honor of Veterans Day on Friday, Nov. 11, the Sedgwick County Division on Aging will hold an event to recognize local veteran volunteers who continue to serve their communities through the local RSVP program.

The event will be held this afternoon at 1:30 p.m. at the Robert Dole VA Medical Center Auditorium, 5500 E. Kellogg Ave. County commissioners and manager Mike Scholes will attend along with other local dignitaries.
