1.	04 20 00 2.01	Clarification: Face brick shall have a velour texture. Provide brick with a single 2" radius bullnose corner where shown on the Drawings.
2.	10 10 00 2.03	Locker Room Bench: Bench is to be installed at the east wall of Rm. 107. Replace section with:
		A. Wall mounted, 48" x 20" ADA compliant bench.
		B. Seat constructed of $1\frac{1}{2}$ " maple with radius sides and corners. Finish shall consist of two-coat catalized finish.
		C. Brackets shall be steel, 1 ¹ / ₂ " wide, designed to support a 250 lb. load at any point on a 48" long bench attached thereto. Color shall be black or dark bronze.
		D. Bench shall be Global WG269867 seat with WG269863BK brackets.
		E. Mount brackets to wall with expansion anchors per manufacturer's directions and to resist loading stated herein. Seat height shall be 17" min to 19" maximum above the floor.

Pickets: 5/8" square x 18 Ga (3 ¾" gap between pickets) Posts: 2" square x 16 Ga (G60 galvanized)

1.	C101	Access Road: A drive will be placed connecting Webb Rd to the EMS property before EMS construction commences. The road is not a part of this construction project however the successful bidder will coordinate schedules with the access road contractor. <i>Two questions received regarding roof insulation thickness and type at lower</i>		
		roof.		
2.	A101	Roof Plan: Roof insulation shall be isocyanurate foam board per specifications. Minimum thickness shall be 3". The finish schedule on A600 shows act ceilings at 102, 103, 108 with nothing listed at 113. The ceiling plan on A101 shows these rooms as painted structure. Do we paint the trusses & metal deck in room 113? Would the SS canopy be the same condition?		
3.	A600	Finish Schedule: Ceilings in Rms. 102, 103, 108 & 113 shall be per the Reflected Ceiling Plan on Sheet A101. Painted structure in Rm. 113 includes exposed structural tubing and the underside of the metal deck. Paint underside of metal deck and canopy structure at Patio 112.		
4.	E2.1	Clarification. Manual fire alarm system not required. Self contained duct smoke detector, indicating device and monitoring is required for RTU-1.
