Temporary pavement marking tape may be Type I or II (NO TABS). The contractor shall completely remove any temporary pavement marking prior to the application of the permanent pavement marking.

All methyl methacrylate pavement marking will require removal of existing methyl methacrylate markings and replacement with new material of the same width and color, or of the same lengend or symbol.

Removal method(s) shall be approved by the Engineer, and the method(s) shall not damage the pavement beyond minor scarring due to the method(s) used.

Removal of both temporary and existing pavement markings shall be subsidiary to the bid item "Pavement Marking".

Replacement of existing rumble strips shall be the responsibility of the contractor

Each rumble strip shall be 12" in length, 7" in width and a depth of 1/2" to 5/8" with 5" spacing between each rumble strip

This project shall be completed by September 30, 2014
