SUBJECT: PREA Committee Review for September

On October 16, 2024, the PREA Review Committee met and the following were **PRESENT:**

Meghan Day (Director of Nursing), Ryan Simmons (Health Services Administrator), Cpl. Brittany Baker (Behavior Management Team), Sgt. Caleb Posch (Behavior Management Team), Lt. Clayton Barth (Behavior Management Team) and Lt. Todd Hallacy (PREA Coordinator).

NOT PRESENT:

Capt. Paula Smith (Behavior Management Team), Logan Reich (Behavior Health Coordinator), Kendra Wolff (Mental Health).

The PREA Committee conducted a review of 37 PREA complaints. This review consisted of:

0 Substantiated cases.

17 Unfounded cases.

16 Unsubstantiated cases.

4 Incidents not arising to PREA Standards.

The review considered the following aspects in each case:

In reviewing each of the cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred that could have prevented the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication, in either circumstance, sexual abuse would occur.

In each case review, the committee potentially found no indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status.

The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse and the staffing level was adequate.

Some of the allegations, with one individual, may have been perceived to be aimed at their status as transgender. This individual's claims had to be examined based upon each circumstance and their behavior has been monitored. It was difficult to extract whether the individual was creating allegations upon their own view or if the comments and behavior were occurring.
