

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

The Central Plains Area Agency on Aging (CPAAA) intends to fund caregiver respite services through the Kansas Respite for Alzheimer's & Dementia (K-RAD) program, beginning March 1, 2025, and continuing through June 30, 2025 with the possibility to renew for three (3) additional one (1) year periods (July 1 – June 30). Services provided shall include in-home day respite, congregate out-of-home day respite (adult day program), and out-of-home overnight respite (inpatient). Services are provided to individuals 60 years of age or older who have a written or probable diagnosis of Alzheimer's disease or related dementia and who reside with an informal caregiver 18 years of age or older in Butler, Harvey or Sedgwick County.
