SUBJECT: PREA Committee Review for November

On December 18, 2024, the PREA Review Committee met and the following were **PRESENT:**

Capt. Paula Smith (Behavior Management Team), Ryan Simmons (Health Service Administrator), Meghan Day (Director of Nursing), Logan Reich (Behavior Health Coordinator), Lt. Clayton Barth (Behavior Management Team) and Lt. Todd Hallacy (PREA Coordinator).

NOT PRESENT:

Kendra Wolff (Mental Health). Sgt. Caleb Posch (Behavior Management Team)

The PREA Committee conducted a review of 13 PREA complaints. This review consisted of:

- 2 Substantiated cases.
- 4 Unfounded cases.
- 6 Unsubstantiated cases.
- 1 Incidents not arising to PREA Standards.

The review considered the following aspects in each case:

In reviewing each of the cases, the committee determined policy was followed; nothing occurred that could have prevented the incidents from happening. There were no signs to make an indication, in either circumstance, sexual abuse would occur.

In each case review, the committee potentially found no indication either incident was motivated by race, ethnicity, gender identity, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or intersex identification, status, or perceived status.

In one of the cases, an inmate claimed they believed they might have been targeted due to their perceived status, however, no evidence could be found to support it.

The committee also determined there was no indication of gang affiliation, nor was any of the incidents motivated by or otherwise caused by other group dynamics within the facility.

The committee also determined the area in which the incidents occurred. The physical barriers in the place had no effect on the abuse and the staffing level was adequate.
