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On the recommendation of Britt Rosencutter, on behalf of the Department of Corrections, Philip Davolt moved to accept the Sourcewell Contract #011222-CDT with Technical Resource Management, LLC dba Cordant Health Solutions and establish contract pricing for three (3) years with two (2) one (1) year options to renew. Anna Meyerhoff-Cole seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

This vendor will provide drug testing for the Department of Corrections' clients. The vendor would provide specimen collections as requested and provide negative specimen results the same day the specimen is received by the laboratory. Positive specimen results should be reported the following day. Specimen will be transported for next day delivery at the laboratory's expense. Vendor will provide toxicology services with the ability to test for matrices for all common drugs of abuse as well as specialty and designer drugs.

These services will be utilized across both youth and adult programs within the Department of Corrections. The programs utilizing these services include: Adult Field Services, Pretrial Services, Drug Court, Adult Residential, Work Release, Juvenile Field Services, Juvenile Detention Facility, Home Based Services, and Juvenile Residential Facility.

#### **Questions and Answers**

Brandi Baily: Do you know what the annual spend is on this?

Britt Rosencutter: I'll get that for you.

Brandi Baily: Is this our current vendor?

Britt Rosencutter: It is.

Anna Meyerhoff-Cole: How do the prices compare to the previous contract?

Britt Rosencutter: It has increased. It was five (5) years since we've had the original contract. I don't know the exact increase overall.

Anna Meyerhoff-Cole: Was the increase as expected?

Britt Rosencutter: It certainly looked as expected. The only thing that we had a negotiation with was the affidavit certifying. That's part of the package.

#### Additional information:

Price increases ranged from 4% to 7% depending on the panel. The costs of saliva panels decreased by 15%. The annual spend for eight (8) programs for 2024 is \$137,674.16.

On the recommendation of Britt Rosencutter, on behalf of Regional Forensic Science Center, Tim Myers moved to accept the quote from Waters Technologies Corporation (Waters) in the amount of \$91,216.27 for a three (3) year contract period. Anna Meyerhoff-Cole seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

This three (3) year service plan will cover annual maintenance on the LC-MS/MS (liquid chromatograph - mass spectrometry) instrument previously purchased using Opioid Settlement Funding, which has replaced two (2) instruments that reached obsolescence. RFSC purchased an extended warranty to cover the period of 8/2/2023 - 8/1/2025 and wishes to continue that service for nearly three (3) additional years at which time the service quote will be revised to include both LC-MS/MS instruments onsite. This agreement is expected to be well within the life-span of this instrumentation.

This critical equipment is used by the Toxicology Laboratory for the detection and quantification of drugs and drug metabolites when analyzing biologicals for the presence of drugs of abuse in both postmortem and antemortem casework. The service plan fully covers all of the instrumentation and includes the annual preventative maintenance visits that are required for accreditation.

Waters manufactures the LC-MS/MS and is the exclusive provider of service plans and parts. Waters provides on-site diagnostic evaluation and repair, which minimizes the time staff would otherwise spend troubleshooting.

#### Notes:

The spend to cover the three (3) instruments that were replaced after reaching obsolescence in 2021 was \$83,523.87 [one (1) year cost for three (3) instruments].

The agreement to cover the other LC-MS/MS was executed in 2023, following a two (2) year extended warranty purchase at a 35% point of sale discount, and includes the following pricing:
